For more than a century, the Partners Fund has granted generous gifts from our community where they are needed most.



About the Future

In 2025, we plan to:

- Increase by 150% the number of Atlantans who participate in an Israel experience via programs such as Birthright Israel, Onward Israel, Momentum Unlimited, RootOne and Honeymoon Israel
- Build on our new partnership with Nahal Oz, a kibbutz in the Gaza envelope, and supporting them in their evolving needs
- Continue a robust partnership with the citizens of Yokneam Meggido, including the relaunch of an educator exchange program, with two planned seminars and ten teachers from communities participating representing a 50% increase in seminars and attendees
- Initiate greater opportunities for collaboration across community day schools in areas that promote enrollment growth and excellence with a focus on marketing and professional development
- Double the number of pre-schools participating in a pilot initiative in partnership with JF&CS to provide play therapy-based services to Jewish early childhood educators, learners, and families
- Through grants given to Moishe House and Honeymoon Israel, enhance the relationship with young adults and Israel through the creation of 15 new events and learning retreats

A Partners Fund recipient program, Honeymoon Israel, helps young people and their partners get to Israel. Because of this opportunity, Ali's life was transformed.

"I am a wife and mother to a 4-year-old, currently residing in Atlanta but originally from South Florida. When I first moved to town, I encountered numerous challenges such as the absence of Jewish friends, a synagogue, or a strong Jewish identity. Honeymoon Israel was instrumental in helping me find my community. In 2018, my husband and I traveled to Israel, an experience that proved to be transformational for both our lives and our marriage. Now, we incorporate various elements of Jewish tradition into our lives. We use Honeymoon Israel candle holders to recite blessings together on Friday nights, and my husband has adopted his favorite Honeymoon Israel challah recipe and cover. I am immensely grateful for the programs supported by Federation in our community."
