

Jewish Education Tax Credit



The Jewish Education Tax Credit (JETC) is an initiative that enables deserving students to access quality Jewish education that may otherwise be out of reach.

As Georgia taxpayers, you are eligible to receive a 100% state income tax credit in exchange for your contribution to this program.

The funds raised through your contributions provide tuition assistance and access to high-quality Jewish education for eligible students in participating Jewish schools from pre-kindergarten through twelfth grade.

It's a win-win situation: You can make a meaningful contribution, help support and strengthen our schools, and fulfill your tax obligations.

- Average scholarship award amount: **\$8,640.57**
