



AgeWell Atlanta IMPACT REPORT

AgeWell Atlanta is a pioneering collaborative partnership between Jewish Family & Career Services (JF&CS), the Marcus Jewish Community Center of Atlanta (MJCCA), Jewish HomeLife and Jewish Federation of Greater Atlanta.

Together, they provide a continuum of services and support which help older adults and caregivers age well through improved independence, quality of life, and social connection.



Mr. Smith (changed name) called 1-866-AGEWELL to talk with the concierge about getting help to obtain an electric wheelchair, something he desperately needed in order to continue his part-time job.

Mr. Smith explained that his financial situation required him to keep working, but also that he really enjoyed his job and the contributions he was able to make there.

Working together, AgeWell Atlanta was able to connect him to resources to help him get the device he needed to continue working. He was able to preserve his independence while maintaining his safety.

WHY AGEWELL ATLANTA?

PEOPLE ARE LIVING LONGER WHILE BIRTH RATES ARE DECLINING. BY 2030, ONE IN FIVE ATLANTANS WILL BE OVER THE AGE OF 60.

THE 2016 COMMUNITY STUDY FOR THE GREATER ATLANTA JEWISH COMMUNITY REPORTED 67% OF ADULT RESPONDENTS 65 AND OLDER INDICATE THEY INTEND TO REMAIN IN THEIR CURRENT HOME AS THEY AGE.

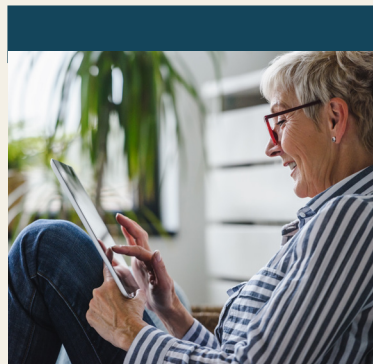
