## Services Our Community-Wide Security Program Has Provided since 2020

### **Examples of our LiveSecure Donor Investments:**

\$25,000 of LiveSecure funds to the Atlanta Jewish Film Festival to secure the event

\$380,000 to deploy Flock Safety License Plate Reading Smart Cameras at 34 organizations

\$682,000 to deploy BluePoint Alert Active Shooter Response System

\$7,500 for Security Training Kits

\$9,000 for Bleeding Control Skills Training Kits

\$60,000 for Security for Community Wide Events

**\$70,000** for Night Locks for all classrooms in Jewish ATL institutions

## **Next Steps:**

Currently we are reassessing all 70+ agencies to determine the security enhancements that have been implemented and what each may need today. This will clarify if additional funds need to be raised and how they will be allocated.

Additionally, a LiveSecure Allocations Committee has been created to review applications and allocate LiveSecure funds appropriately based on the needs identified. Federation's community-wide security team will serve as expert advisors to the committee.
