PJ Library is a national program of the Harold Grinspoon Foundation that sends Jewish children (from birth through 12 years), a free, age-appropriate Jewish themed book each month. PJ Library brings Jewish families with young children together in their own neighborhoods and helps them build community. We offer high quality, low barrier, and inclusive Jewish experiences that respond to the needs and interests of families.
