For more than a century, the Partners Fund has granted generous gifts from our community where they are needed most.

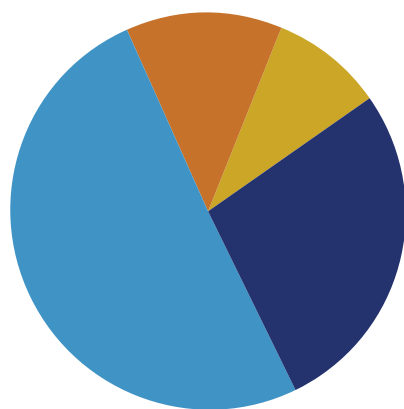
