
IMPACTREPORT

Responding to the emergency in Ukraine, Jewish Atlanta raised more than \$2.6 million to assist those directly impacted by the war. Working with our partners Jewish Federations of North America, Jewish Agency for Israel, and the Joint Distribution Committee, North American Jewish communities provided \$73 million. These dollars have made real impact.
